- Defending home inspectors in claims involving a buyer's discovery of water infiltration, mould development, structural deficiencies, and electrical and plumbing deficiencies following the purchase of a home
- Defending engineers and architects in claims involving allegations of negligent structural, mechanical, and landscape design
- Drafting pleadings, motion materials, and reports to insurance and noninsurance clients, including opinions on the scope and limitations of home inspections
- Advocating for clients in mediations to secure reasonable resolutions, including on the basis of enforcing limitation of liability clauses and return of inspection fees
- Assessing damages claims against home inspectors on the basis of the diminution in value of properties
- Conducting and defending examinations for discovery, including on the scope and limitations of his client's services, to significantly reduce his client's exposure
- Retaining experts to provide opinions on standard of care and assessment of damages as part of the defence strategy
- Working with home inspection companies to review and develop inspection agreements to incorporate the relevant standards of practice and limitation of liability terms
